Pray for the churches of our community ...

... for unity among believers (John 17:22-23, Phil. 2:1-2)

... that we would praise God together (Psalm 67:5-7)

- ... for strength and joy for our brothers and sisters who will suffer and die for their faith (Rev. 7:9,14)

Prayers from the New Testament ...

... for the salvation of Jewish people

Brothers, my heart's desire and prayer to God for the Israelites is that they may be saved. (Romans 10:1)

... for unity among Christ's followers

... to glorify God with one heart and one mouth

May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you a spirit of unity among yourselves as you follow Christ Jesus, so that with one heart and mouth you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. (Romans 15:5-6)

... to be filled with joy and peace in believing

... to overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit

May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. (Romans 15:13)

... to have wisdom and revelation

... to know the glorious Father better

... to know the hope to which we are called and His great power for us

I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better. I pray also that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, and his incomparably great power for us who believe. (Ephesians 1:17-19)

... to be strengthened with power:

**so that Christ may dwell in our hearts,
that we may grasp the depth of Christ's love, and
that we may be filled up with this love that
surpasses knowledge**

I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge--that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God. (Ephesians 3:16-19)

... for our love to increase in knowledge and insight

... to be able to discern what is best and be pure and blameless

And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless until the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ--to the glory and praise of God. (Philippians 1:9-11)

... to be equipped with everything to do his will

May the God of peace ... equip you with everything good for doing his will, and may he work in us what is pleasing to him, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. (Hebrews 13:20-21)

... to be filled with the knowledge of His will, in order to please Him in every way

... to bear fruit and grow in the knowledge of God

... to be strengthened with His power

in order to have endurance and patience

... to be joyfully giving thanks to the Father

For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you and asking God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all spiritual wisdom and understanding. And we pray this in order that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and may please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God, being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience, and joyfully giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in the kingdom of light. (Colossians 1:9-12)

... for our love to overflow for one another

... to be strengthened in heart, in order to be blameless and holy

May the Lord make your love increase and overflow for each other and for everyone else, just as ours does for you. May he strengthen your hearts so that you will be blameless and holy in the presence of our God and Father when our Lord Jesus comes with all his holy ones. (1 Thessalonians 3:12-13)

... for the Gospel message to spread rapidly and be honored

... to be delivered from wicked and evil men

... for our hearts to be full of God's love and Christ's perseverance

Finally, brothers, pray for us that the message of the Lord may spread rapidly and be honored, just as it was with you. And pray that we may be delivered from wicked and evil men, for not everyone has faith. But the Lord is faithful, and he will strengthen and protect you from the evil one. We have confidence in the Lord that you are doing and will continue to do the things we command. May the Lord direct your hearts into God's love and Christ's perseverance. (2 Thessalonians 3:1-5)

... to be active in sharing our faith, in order to understand the good we have in Christ

I pray that you may be active in sharing your faith, so that you will have a full understanding of every good thing we have in Christ. (Philemon 6)

... to enjoy good health and for all to go well

Dear friend, I pray that you may enjoy good health and that all may go well with you, even as your soul is getting along well. (3 John 1:2)
